- Access to public transport is limited.
- It's difficult to get on to a bus or walk any distance.

P4W Transport operates a value-for-money community transport scheme in Inverness with dedicated volunteer drivers. The scheme meets the individual needs of people in Inverness who are unable to access public transport and have no transport of their own.

Clients who use the scheme are able to have transport to and from health and social care facilities in their community.

The service operates on weekdays between 9.00am and 4.30pm.

Clients are asked to pay a small charge of £8 return or £5 single toward the cost of the service.
